Adequate Interaction / Discussion with the Students in the Online Classroom was Carried Out



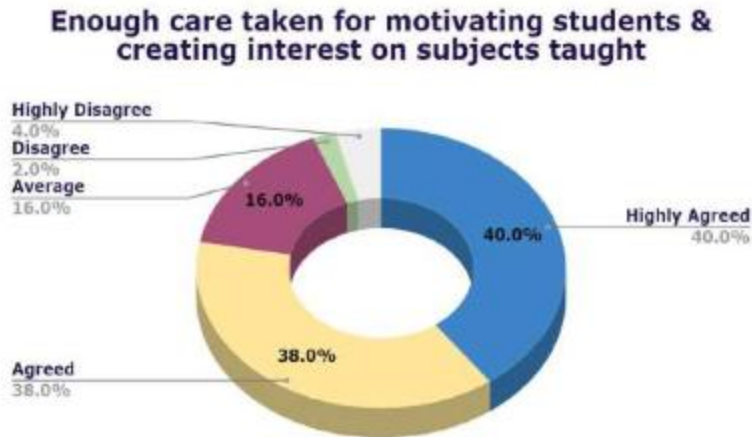

Supportive Attitude towards Students with Mentoring Initiatives was demonstrated

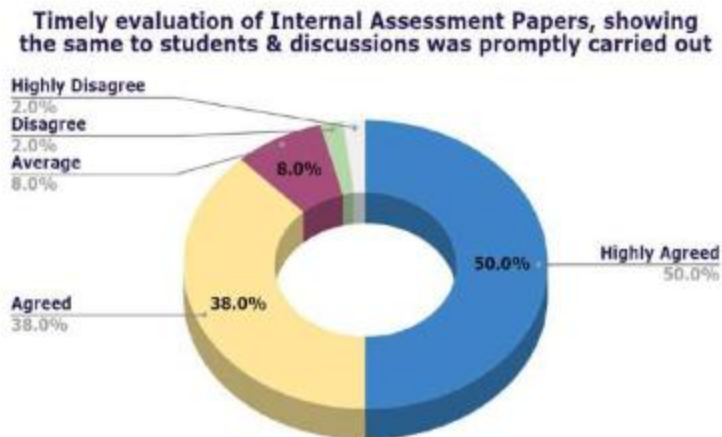

FACULTY FEEDBACK

For efficient and quality improvement of an educational institute, feedback plays a key role in it. With a proper feedback mechanism in place; the growth rate of an institute shows an upward movement. The feedback mechanism helps in catering the weaknesses and further strengthening the strengths. The SWOT Analysis of an institute can be done by ensuring a strong feedback system is in place.

Faculty evaluation has been defined (Miller 1987) as either

(1) A process designed to improve faculty performance (a development process)

OR

(2) A procedure that assists in making personnel decisions (a reviewing process)

Budge Budge Institute of Technology (BBIT) participates to make the process more effective so that the evaluation can be carried out in a seamless manner. The evaluation process is collegial and professional. The college allows for the recognition of good performance rather than focussing on areas for improvement.

Evaluation is an integral part of any technical institute. Although there are various methods of teachers' evaluation, student's feedback is considered as the most effective and reliable method albeit a controversial one.

Common feedback form is designed at the institutional level for all programmes by considering all the dimensions of the technical learning process such as percentage of syllabus completion, communication skills, punctuality and regularity, student interaction, subject knowledge, etc. The feedback form is distributed manually to each student and the filled forms are collected back by the admin staff so as to maintain the anonymous status of the students.

The data is analysed on a scale of 0 to 10 and **Net Performance Weighted Index (NPWI)** is calculated for each and every department. The Feedback Analysis has few sample of each and every faculty of each department.
